

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the C94 Choseley Road from a point 10 metres north of its junction with the B1153 Brancaster Road for a distance of 20 metres northwards in the PARISH OF DOCKING because of drainage, new road layout and footway works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 24th September 2020 to 22nd October 2020 for the duration of the works, expected to be 29 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Choseley Road, Brancaster Road, Mill Road, Main Road, High Street, Thornham Road, Ringstead Road, Docking Road (Thornham, Choseley, Brancaster, Titchwell, Docking).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

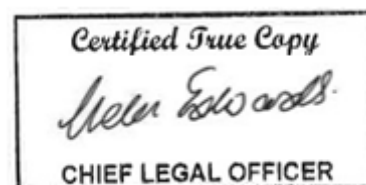

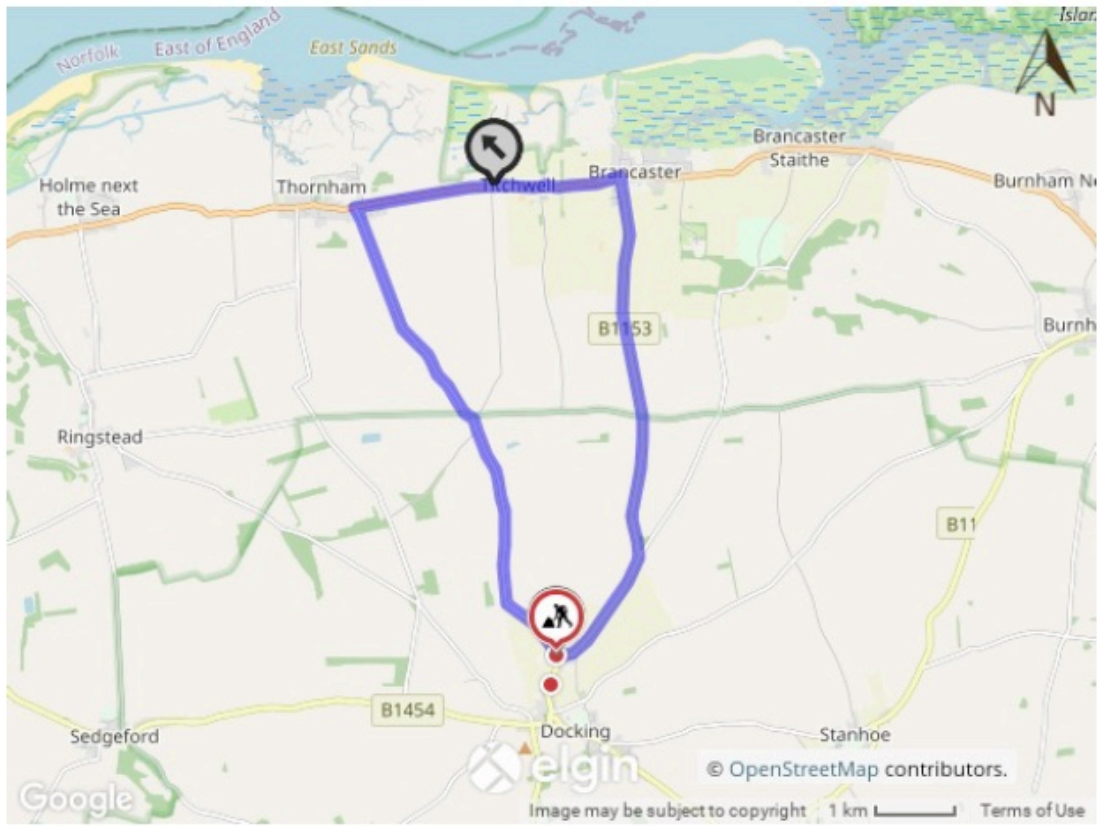
