



Thornham Neighbourhood Development Plan

Decision Statement

Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) Section 61E (4)(b) Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, Regulations 19 & 20

BACKGROUND

Thornham Parish Council has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan. This has successfully passed its independent examination and a local referendum, and is now being brought into force by the Borough Council (as the local planning authority for the area). The Neighbourhood Plan will now form part of the development plan for the whole of the Parish of Thornham, and be used to help guide development and make decisions on planning applications in Thornham Parish.

DECISION

The Borough Council decided on 27 July 2021 to 'make' (bring into legal force) the Thornham Neighbourhood Development Plan with effect from 27 July 2021.

REASON

The amended (as per recommended by the independent examiner) Thornham Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the Basic Conditions and other legal requirements, and was supported by a majority of votes in a local referendum held on 22 July 2021.
