23/01238/F Details: Remove Condition 1 and Variation of Conditions 2,3,4,5,11,14 and 15 of Planning Permission 22/01913/F: Construction of 2 new dwellings following demolition of existing dwelling at Lombardy High Street Thornham Hunstanton Norfolk: Comments: The only observation is the pleached trees along the boundary alongside the windows of the neighbouring property should not be any higher than the permitted height of 1.8 metres. A condition be placed on the lighting bollards in line with the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) Clause 180c and Norfolk County Council's Environmental Lighting Zones Policy both recognise the importance of preserving dark landscapes and dark skies. In order to minimise light pollution, we recommend that any outdoor lights associated wit the proposed development should be:

1. Fully shielded (Enclosed in full cut-off flat glass fitments)

- 2. Directed downwards (Mounted horizontally to the ground and not tilted upwards)
- 3. Switched on only when needed (no dusk to dawn lamps)
- 4. White light low-energy lamps (LED) and not orange or pink sodium sources.
